You've got a Super Power...

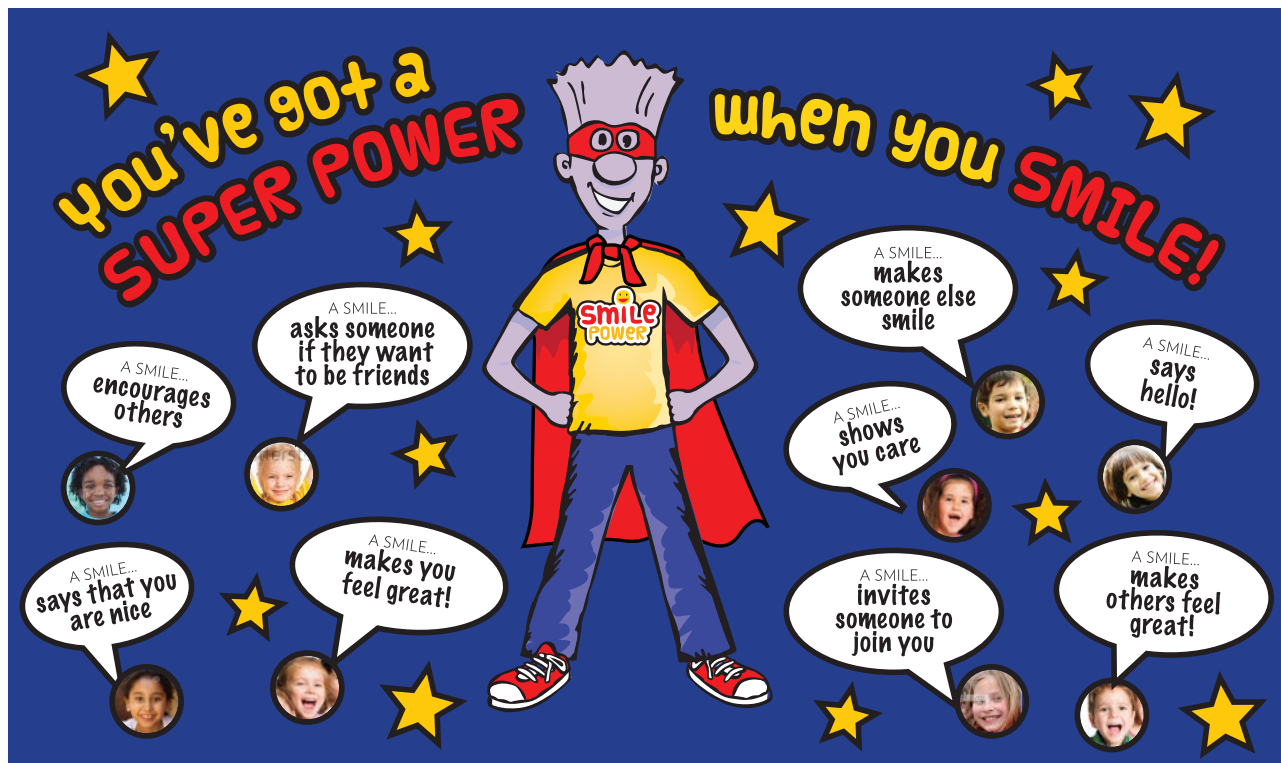
Create this fun and colorful board to remind your students the amazing power of a smile!

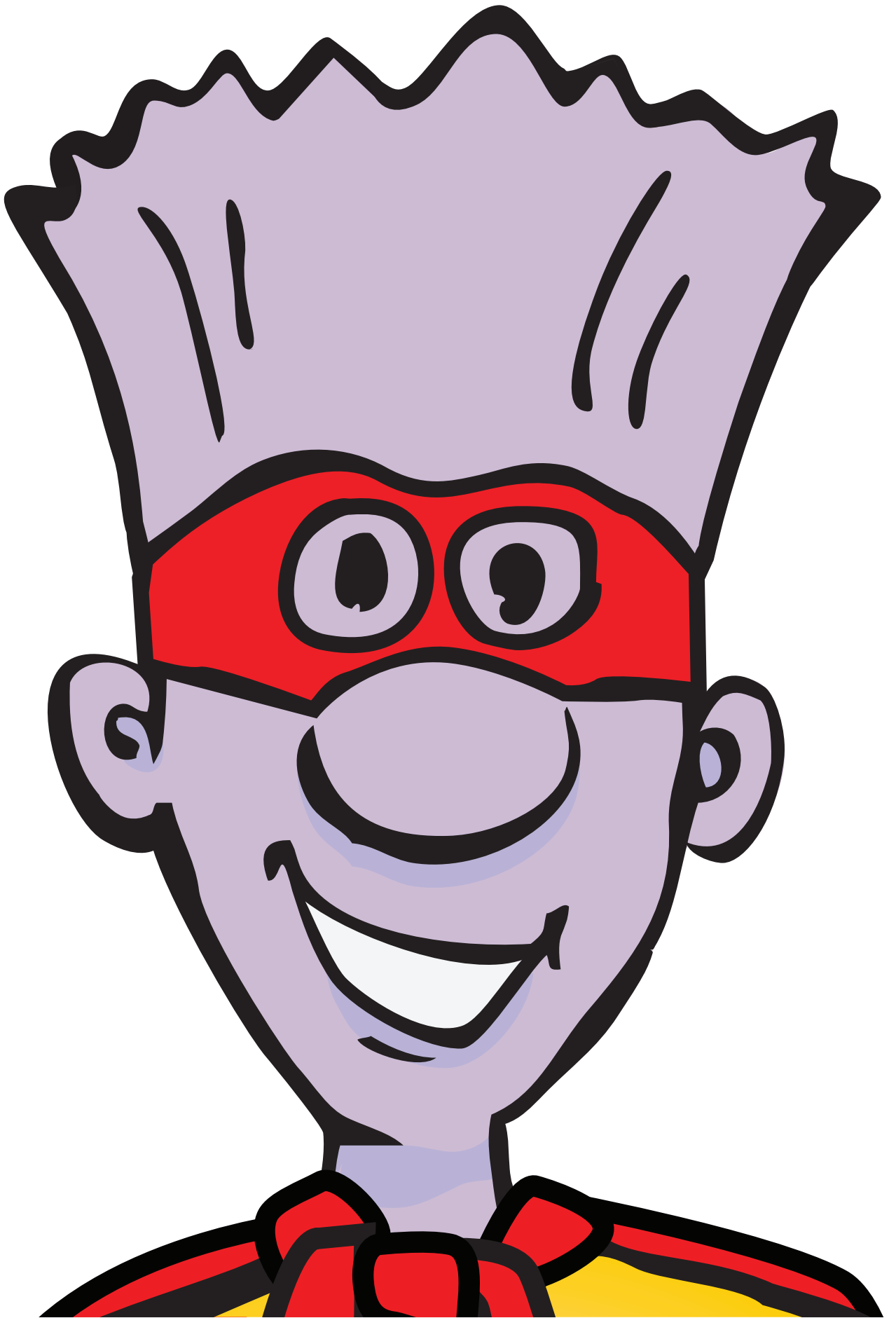
What you'll need:

- 8-1/2 x 11" white paper (cardstock recommended)
- Color printer
- Dark blue paper for the background
- Photos of your student's smiling faces! (Cut into 3" circles or larger)
- Scissors and adhesive (tape or glue).
- Markers

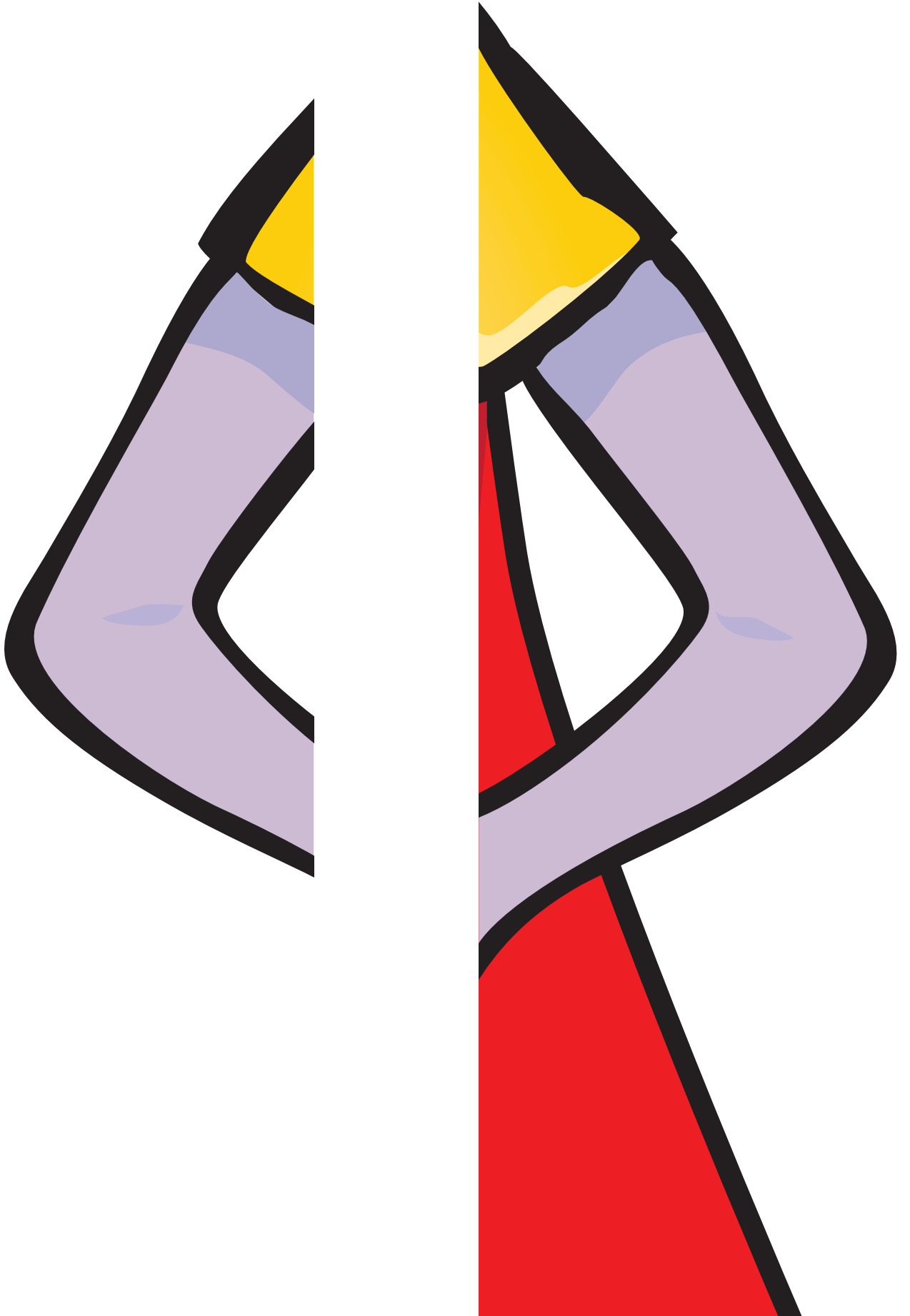
Directions:

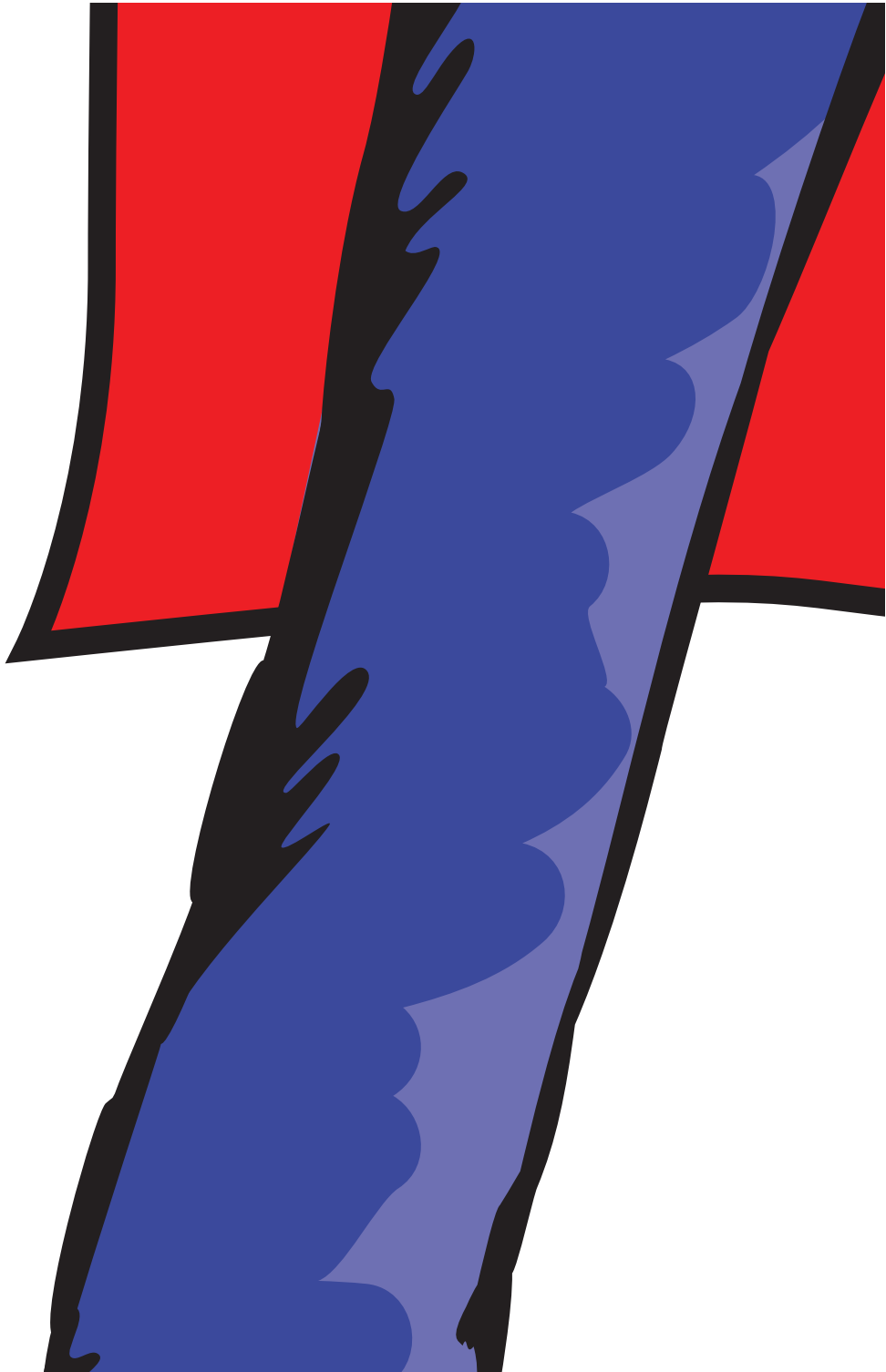
1. Print pages 2-7 (Super NED) cut and piece together.
2. Print pages 8-11 (letters), cut
3. Blank speech bubbles are on pages 12-17. Ask students "What happens when YOU smile?" and "What does a Smile mean to others?" Write their responses in the speech bubbles.
4. Print pages 18-26 if you want to use the speech bubbles shown below.
5. Print and cut 10 yellow stars on pages 27-28.
6. Cut out kids face photos (we used 3" circles).
7. Assemble your bulletin board.

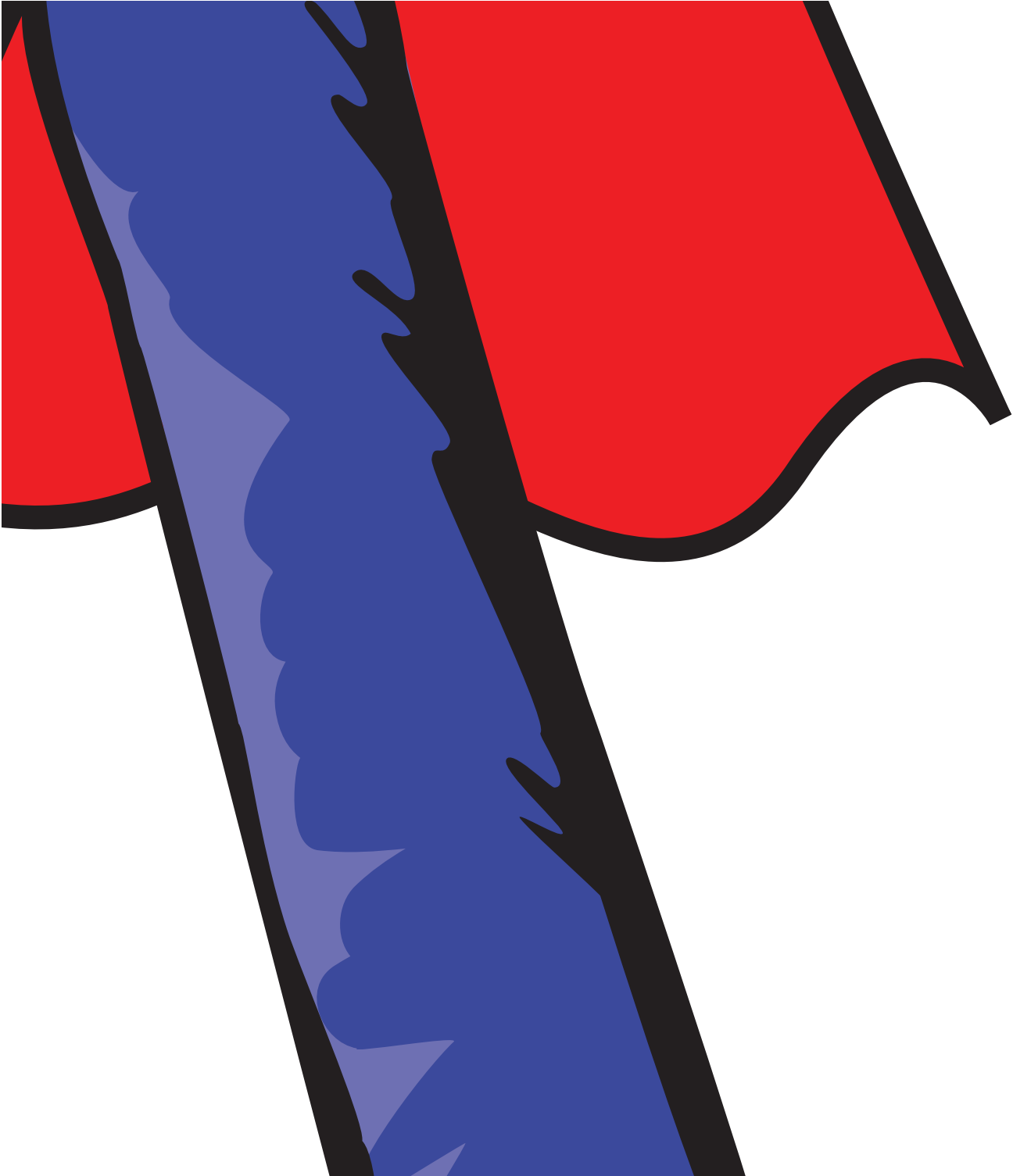














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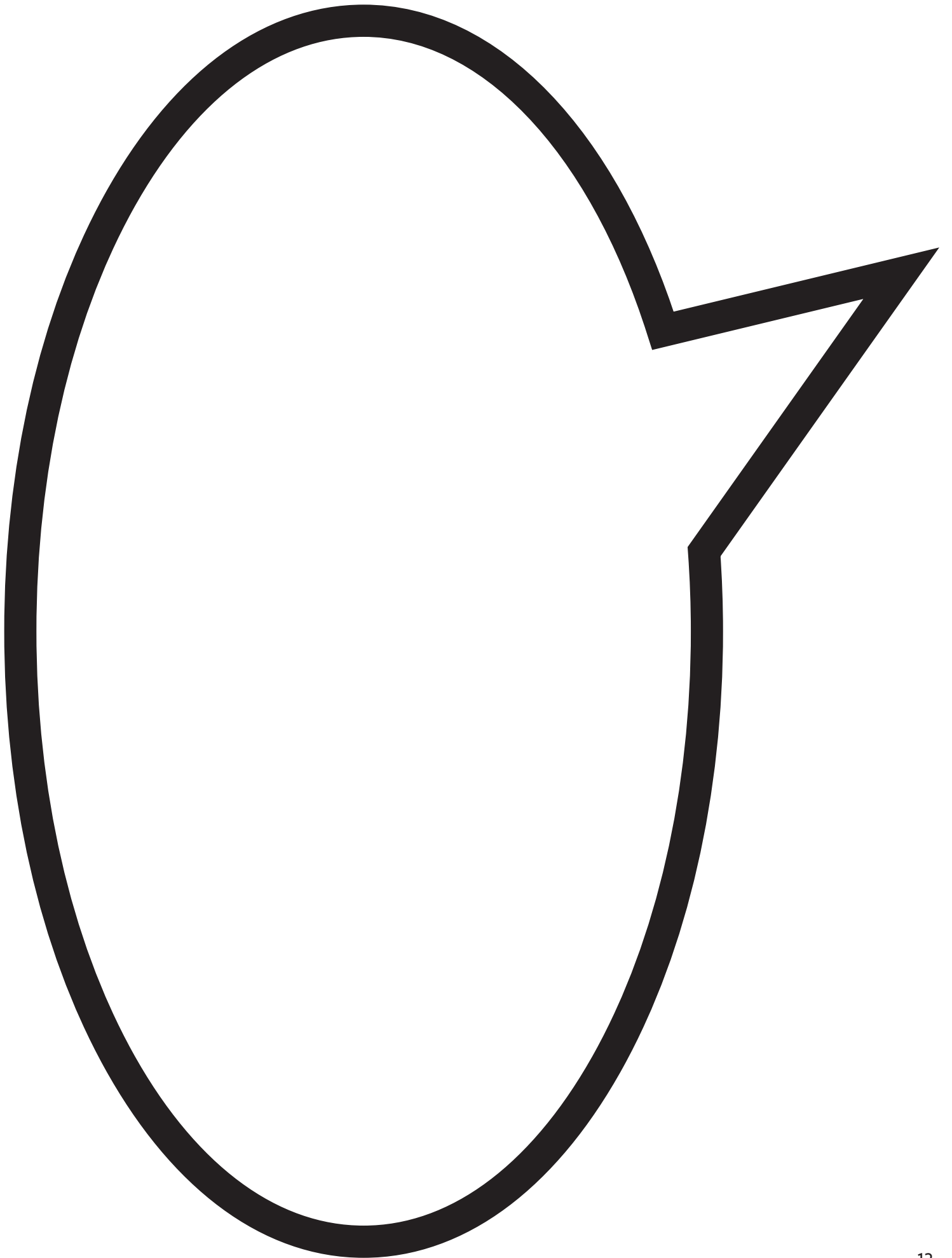
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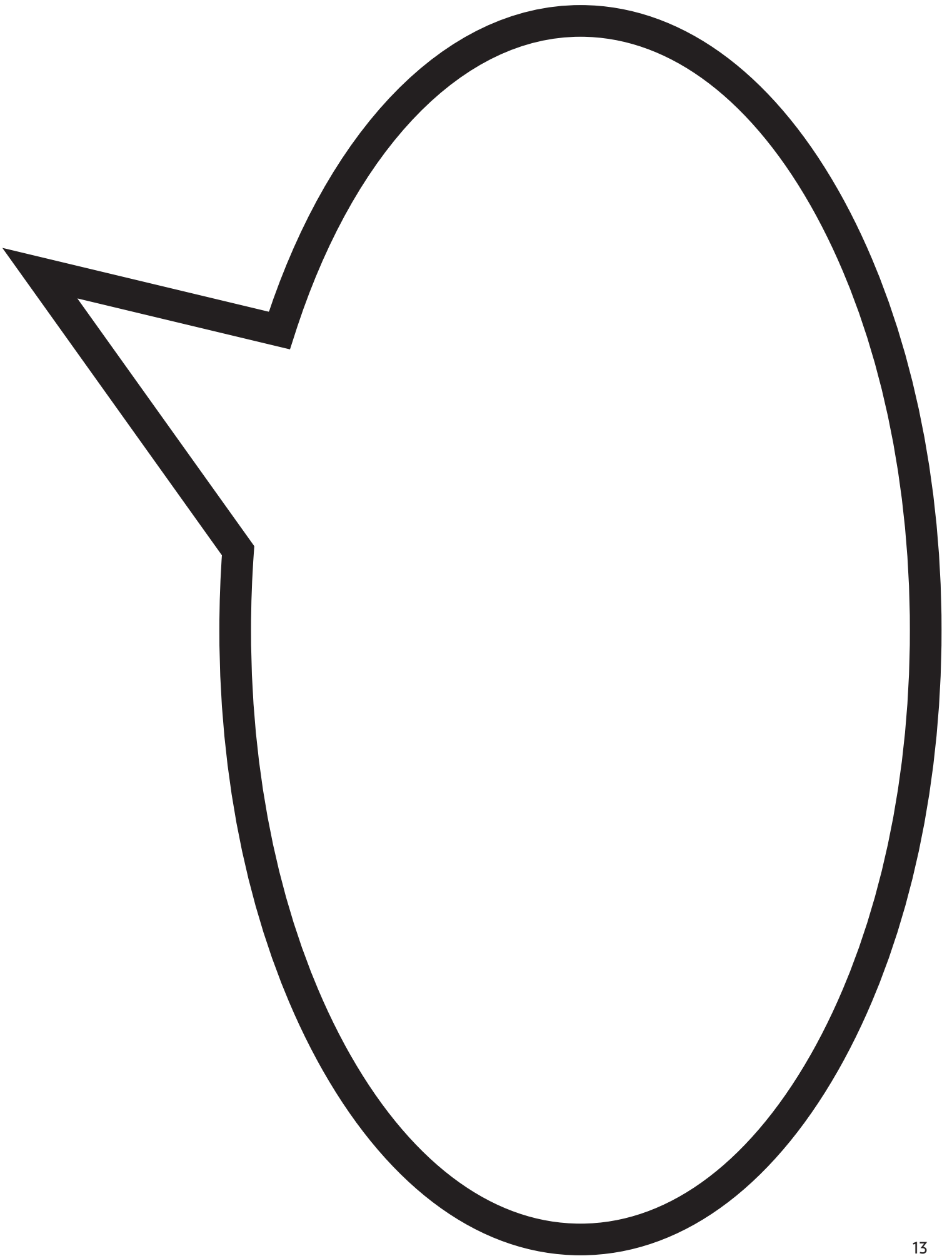
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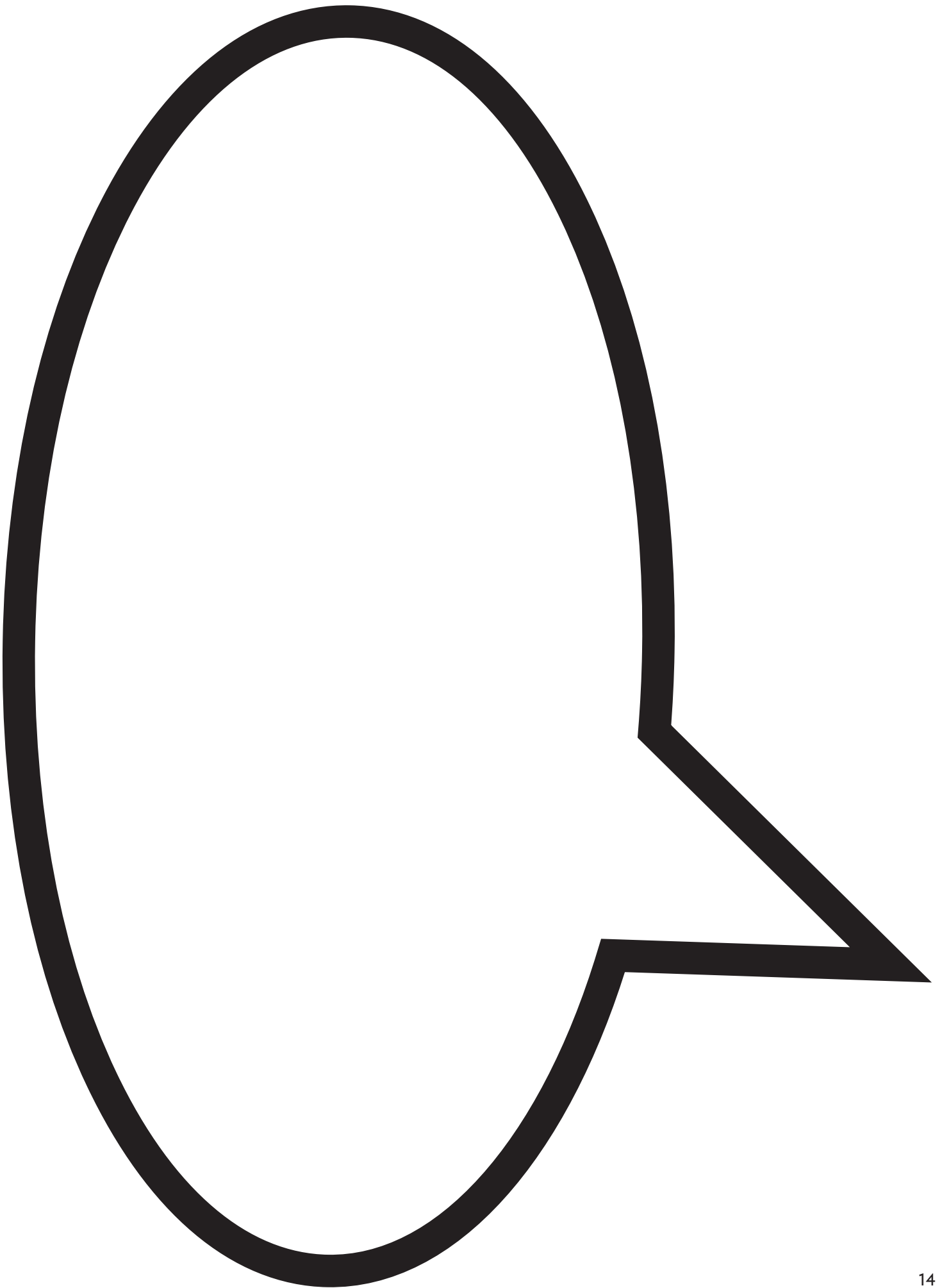
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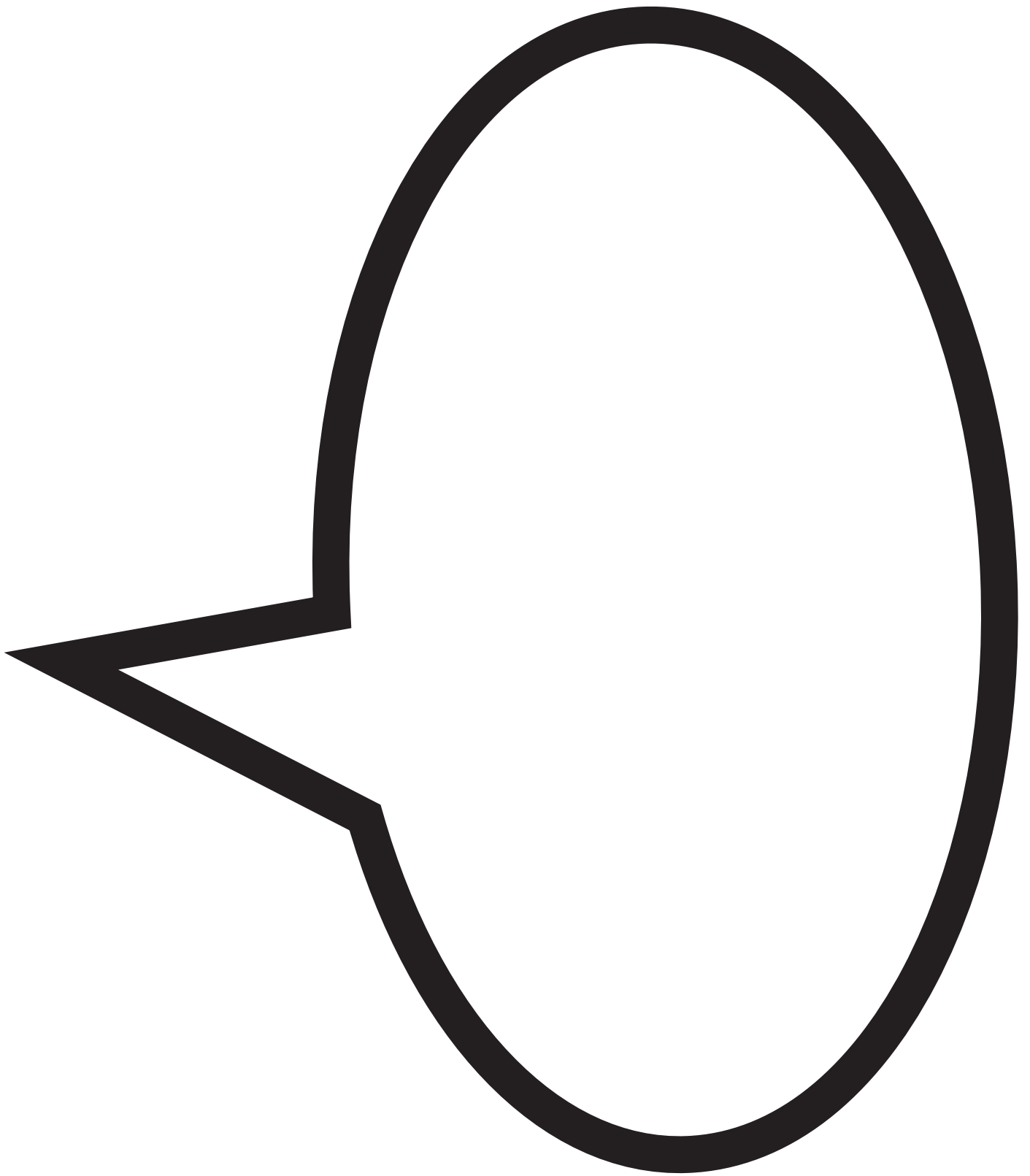
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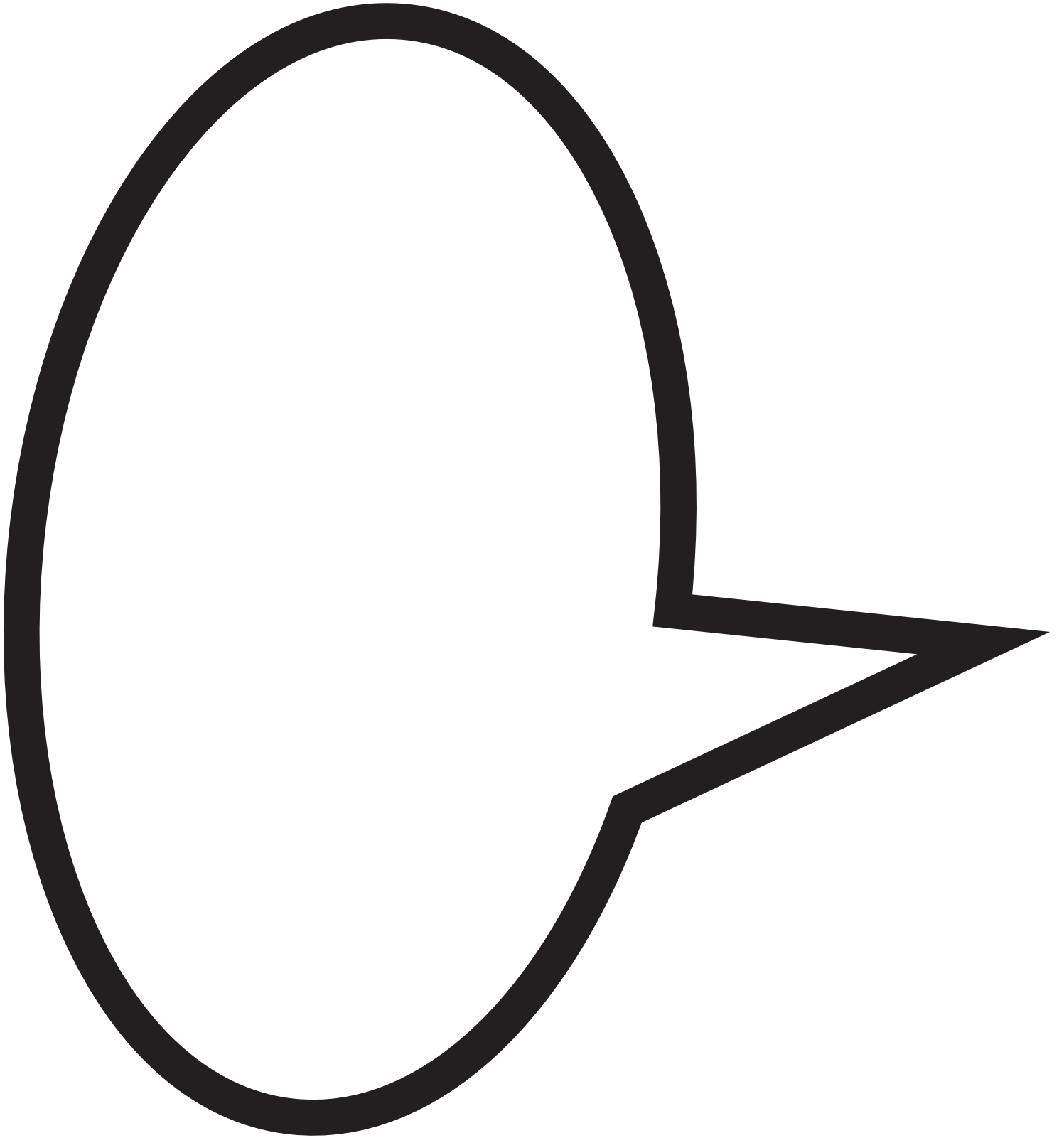
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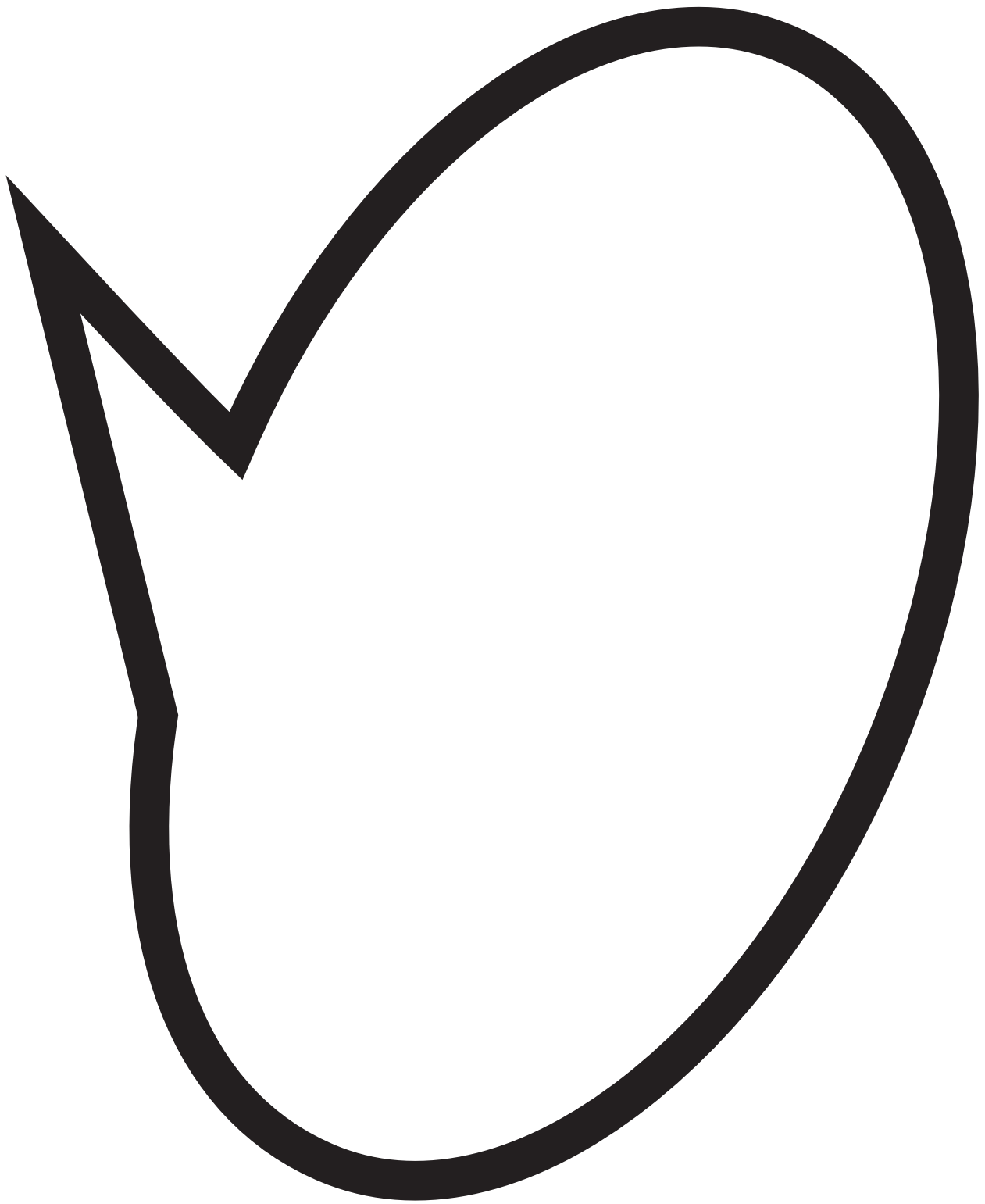
