

performance area set-up requirements

The floor-seating plan below allows every student to have a better view of the performer. Not only is it quieter than using chairs, but students are also closer to the performer which enhances connection with the students and the magic of the show!

capacity

Up to 1200 students can sit camp-style for a single show. If no stage is available, it is especially important that the students are seated on the floor.

performance area

If the performance area is a stage, the performer needs an easy way to walk off center stage into the audience to interact with the students. Steps work well, preferably without a railing that could block views.

Please have the performance area cleared and three 6' (2m) tables, two chairs and a wastebasket set up at least 90-minutes before the show. The performer needs at least 9' (2.75m) ceiling clearance in the performance area.

set-up and tear-pown time

A 90-minute minimum setup time is required for the show and 75-minute

Power access


This is an indoor media show. We bring our own sound system, microphone, rear projector and screen. Please bring power to the stage if outlet is further than 15' (4.5m) away.
